

Good afternoon

On Monday 19 October, we began an 18-month project to improve street lighting, which will reduce council energy bills and lower carbon emissions. Between then and March 2022, we will upgrade a total of 16,000 street light units to high efficiency LED lanterns and replace 3,000 concrete columns as part of a countywide project.

The work is being supported by a £2.4 million interest free loan from Salix Finance Ltd, which provides Government funding to the public sector to improve energy efficiency, reduce carbon emissions and lower energy bills.

I am pleased to say that Phase Two of this project is now underway and will take place in the following roads in Battle between now until October 2021:

- High Street
- Abbey Green
- Caldbeck Hill
- Market Road
- Sunny Rise

This work will involve upgrading/replacing any older style street light columns and lanterns and will not involve replacing all streetlights in the above roads.
