

Battle Town Council 1066 Writing Competition

Notes from Cllrs Gyngeell, Davies and Favell, following a meeting of the Writing Competition Working Group on 18 June 2018.

Competition for children:

It was noted that ER&TD had agreed that children may enter the competition through youth organisations in addition to schools. It was agreed to recommend to Council that the number of entries would no longer be limited to three per year group.

GF will make contact with Scouts/Cubs/Guides/Brownies in 1066 Country and the ATC and enquire about other youth groups in Battle (Baptist Church, Emmanuel Church etc.)

W/G will visit schools to make contact to ask who is best to leave flyers for and obtain their school email address. A brief note about possible ways of interpreting the title could include creative writing, using art as a stimulus for descriptive writing, local studies, history and environmental studies.

JG will visit state primary schools in North 1066 Country and also CCC.

CD will visit state primary schools in SE 1066 Country and Buckswood.

GF will visit the remaining state senior schools in 1066 Country and state primary schools in SW 1066 Country

It is recommended that winners are given medals as a keepsake.

Competition for adults:
